# 1. Jesus is <u>looking</u> for me!

## > Go and look for others!

Philip found Nathanael and told him, 'We have found the One Moses wrote about in the Law (and so did the prophets): Jesus the son of Joseph, from Nazareth!'

(John 1:45, HCSB)

The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your fellow Israelites. You must listen to him.'
(Deuteronomy 18:15, New Living Translation)

'Can anything good come out of Nazareth?' Nathanael asked him. (John 1:46, HCSB)

'Come and see,' Philip answered. (John 1:46, HCSB)

Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you. (John 1:48, HCSB)

## 2. Jesus sees me!

'Rabbi,' Nathanael replied, 'You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!' (John 1:49, HCSB)

**Believe** in Him.

If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and <u>believe</u> in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

(Romans 10:9, NLT)

Jesus responded to him, 'Do you believe only because I told you I saw you under the fig tree? You will see greater things than this.' (John 1:50, HCSB)
