#### HOW TO RECOGNIZE "THE WICKED" - THE PEOPLE I SHOULD AVOID

The wicked are too proud to seek God.

(Psalm 10:4, NLT)

"There is no peace for the wicked," says the LORD. (Isaiah 48:22 and Isaiah 57:21, HCSB)

There are seven things that the LORD hates and cannot tolerate: A proud look, a lying tongue... (Proverbs 6:16, TEV)

You must not misuse the name of the LORD your God. The LORD will not let you go unpunished if you misuse his name. (Exodus 20:7, NLT)

Careless words stab like a sword, but wise words bring healing. (Proverbs 12:18, NCV)

Don't Take the Path of Sinners. (Psalm 1:1, HCSB)

The men of Sodom were wicked exceedingly and sinners against the LORD.
