#### **But Why?**

Part 5- Why Doesn't God Answer My Prayers? May  $5^{th}$ , 2023

### 1. In this world, we will face <u>problems</u> and <u>difficulties</u>.

Here on earth, you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, for I have overcome the world. (John 16:33, New Living Translation)

People are born for trouble as readily as sparks fly up from a fire. (Job 5:7, New International Version)

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will not be afraid, for you are close beside me – your rod and your staff they comfort me. (Psalms 23:4, English Standard Version)

#### 2. God knows how much it hurts

Have mercy on me, Lord, for I am faint. Heal me Lord, for my bones are in agony.... Among the dead, nobody proclaims your name.... I am worn out from my groaning. All night long I flood my bed with weeping and drench my couch with tears. (Psalm 6:2-6, NIV)

### 3. Our trials can often reveal the depth of our <u>faith</u> in Christ.

I was given a thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to torment me.

Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. But He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."

(2 Corinthians 8-9, NIV)

# 3. God sometimes allows suffering so that His name will be praised when the <u>healing</u> comes.

Rabbi, who sinned, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind.

(John 9:2, NIV)

Neither this man, nor his parents sinned", said Jesus, "but this happened so that the works of God might be displayed in him." (John 9:3, NIV)

So do not fear, for I am with you: do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
