### WHY SHOULD I BE ARMED AND READY?

## 1. We have a real enemy!

For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against <u>evil rulers and authorities</u> of the unseen world, against <u>mighty powers</u> in this dark world, and against <u>evil</u> <u>spirits</u> in the heavenly places. (Ephesians 6:12, NLT)

Then there was war in heaven. . . . the ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, the one deceiving the whole world—was thrown down to the earth with all his angels.

(Revelation 12:7–9, NLT)

# 2. Satan is a bully.

Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour. Stand firm against him.

(1 Peter 5:8-9, NLT)

Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. (James 4:7, NLT)

# 3. I need **EVERY** piece of God's armor to survive.

Put on every piece of God s armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. (Ephesians 6:13, NLT)

## **HOW DO I GET ARMED AND READY?**

#### Put on the Belt of Truth.

Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth.

(Ephesians 6:14, NLT)

# 1. Support yourself with truth from God's Word.

Teach them your word, which is truth.

(John 17:17, NLT)

The word of the Lord will live forever.

(1 Peter 1:25, New Century Version)

# 2. Strengthen yourself by acting on truth.

Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock. (Matthew 7:24, NLT)

# 3. <u>Surround</u> yourself with people who <u>tell</u> you truth.

A person standing alone can be attacked and defeated, but two can stand back-to-back and conquer. Three are even better.

(Ecclesiastes 4:12, NLT)
