WHY DO I NEED THE BOOTS OF PEACE?

1. The boots of peace give you <u>stability</u>.

There is lasting peace for those who love your teachings. Nothing can make those people stumble.
(Psalm 119:165, God's Word)

2. The boots of peace prepare you for <u>any</u> situation.

Whatever house you enter, first say, Peace be to this house.

(Luke 10:5, New American Standard Bible 1995)

If a man of peace is there, your peace will rest on him. (Luke 10:6, NASB95)

HOW DO I BECOME A MAN OF PEACE?

1. Make Peace with God.

We have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us. (Romans 5:1, NLT)

If we admit that we have sinned, he will forgive us our sins. (1 John 1:9, New International Revised Version)

2. Seek Peace with **Everyone**.

Do all that you can to live in peace with everyone. (Romans 12:18, NLT)

3. Share Peace with your <u>World</u>.

In Christ, God did not hold the world guilty of its sins. And he gave us this message of peace. So we have been sent to speak for Christ. It is as if God is calling to you through us. We speak for Christ when we beg you to be at peace with God.

(2 Corinthians 5:19–20, New Century Version)
