WHAT DOES GOD SAY ABOUT BROKEN AND BLENDED FAMILIES?

1. Remember that your <u>marriage</u> is important to God.

From the beginning 'God made them male and female. 'And he said, 'This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one. 'Since they are no longer two but one, let no one split apart what God has joined together.

(Matthew 19:4-6, NLT)

Didn't the LORD make you one with your wife? In body and spirit you are his. And what does he want? Godly children from your union. So guard your heart; remain loyal to the wife of your youth. For I hate divorce! says the LORD, the God of Israel. (Malachi 2:15–16, NLT)

2. In <u>extreme</u> cases, divorce may be necessary.

Whoever divorces his wife and marries someone else commits adultery—
unless his wife has been unfaithful.(Matthew 19:9, NLT)

Marriage must be honored among all and the marriage bed keptundefiled.(Hebrews 13:4, New English Translation)

But if the husband or wife who isn't a believer insists on leaving, let them go. In such cases the believing husband or wife is no longer bound to the other, for God has called you to live in peace. (1 Corinthians 7:15, NLT)

2) <u>Don't</u> play favorites with your children.

Jacob loved Joseph more than any of his other children But his brothers hated Joseph because their father loved him more than the rest of them. They couldn't say a kind word to him. (Genesis 37:3–4, NLT)

3) <u>Choose</u> to love your "step-family" as your own.

Joseph took Mary as his wife, [and] she gave birth to the son. And Joseph named him Jesus. (Matthew 1:24–25, New Century Version)
