# **Five Purposes for Painful Experiences**

# 1. Use your pain to draw <u>closer to God</u>.

The Lord is close to the brokenhearted; he rescues those whose spirits are crushed. (Psalm 34:18, New Living Translation)

I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature.
(Romans 7:18, NLT)

### 2. Use my pain to draw closer to others.

Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ. (Galatians, 6:2 NIV)

#### 3. Use your pain to grow.

Sometimes it takes a painful experience to make us change our ways. (Proverbs 20:30, Good News Bible)

So even though Jesus was God's son, he learned obedience from the things he suffered. Suffering made Jesus perfect, and now he can save forever all who obey him.

(Hebrews 5:8-9, NLT)

And now, isn't it wonderful all the ways in which this distress has goaded you closer to God? You're more alive, more concerned, more sensitive, more reverent, more human, more passionate, more responsible.

(2 Corinthians 7:11, The Message)

#### 4. Use your pain to serve others.

He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others. When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the same comfort God has given us. For the more we suffer for Christ, the more God will shower us with his comfort through Christ. Even when we are weighed down with troubles, it is for your comfort and salvation! For when we ourselves are comforted, we will certainly comfort you. Then you can patiently endure the same things we suffer.

## 5. Share your story with <u>everyone</u>.

Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. (1 Peter 3:15, NIV)

(Philippians 1:12, NLT)
