#### **Immanuel God with Us**

Week Two- Mighty God

Look! The virgin will conceive a child! She will give birth to a son and will call him Immanuel (which means 'God is with us').

### 2. When you need help, ask our Mighty God to provide.

Until now you have asked for nothing in My name. Ask and you will receive, so that your joy may be complete.

(John 16:24, Holman Christian Standard Bible)
