 - ✓ Set specific time in your schedule to serve someone else, someone in need. You can do this as a family.

Jesus was <u>available</u>.

- Am I paying attention, really paying attention... really listening?
- Are people my focus?
- ✓ Be available to those in need.

Be available by simply starting to smile.
